CREATE A RIVER WALK

Materials

4-6 large plastic containers

water

4-6 different river textures, including moss, twigs, stones or gravel, mud, sand

Towels

Paper (optional)

Basic supplies

Preparation

Arrange plastic bins in a line with shorter ends connected so that it is possible to step from one container to the next. In each container create a different texture experience using the suggestions above. Add water to each container. Towels might be provided on one end to dry off feet.

Directions

- 1. Before you do the river walk take off your shoes and prepare to connect with River.
- Take a slow barefoot walk through these various River textures.

While on the River Walk, you might like to think about the following questions.

- Q What differences do you see in the various textures?
- Q What qualities do they have in common?
- Q What memories of River does this practice call to mind?
- Q How do you feel connected to River?

Beading hope

Materials


Assorted beads String or strong cotton Hand sanitizer or wipes

Directions

We live in a time of climate change when water can come up from the earth or down from the clouds in unexpected and unprecedented ways. We absorb all of this change with worry but Genesis 8:20–22; 9:12–17 urges us to remember the promise of hope.

Tiny beads pop up between Land and Water in this painting, inviting us to find this faith.

- 1. Find your way into the promise of hope by creating a simple bracelet.
- 2. Choose colours that reflect your hope for Creation. You might find inspiration in this painting or the arc between the bows in Genesis. How many colours does hope have?
- 3. When finished, tie your bracelet to your wrist and keep the promise of hope close.
