What You Need

Soil, strainer, magnifying glass, spoons, newspaper

Directions

- 1. Look at the soil through the magnifying glass. What do you see?
- 2. Use the strainer to sift the soil onto the newspaper and examine what is left in the strainer. You may find all kinds of things, like small stones, seeds, feathers, and tiny bugs.
- 3. Write down everything you can see.
- 4. Look at the sifted soil and note the difference!
- 5. Touch the soil and rub it between your fingers, and listen to sound it makes as you make circular motions with soil on the newspaper.
- 6. Smooth it out on the newspaper and draw a picture of something you saw through the magnifying glass.
- 7. What happens when you press it hard between your fingers?




WE CAN ALL CARE FOR THE LAND

What are some of the ways we can all help to care for the land?


In the foot outline below, write down what steps you can take to care for the land better than you are at the moment.
