- 3. Write on some of the branches or leaves some of the things trees provide.


TREE MARKERS


Materials


- 1. You will need wide paddle pop sticks
- 2. Glue
- 3. Permanent pens
- 4. Pipe cleaner
- 5. God's love is all around, and love is, it is meant to be shared.

Instructions

- 1. Make a tree marker by gluing wide paddle pop sticks into a "T" shape
- 2. Decorate with the permanent pens and a pipe cleaner
- 3. Adopt a tree near the church or your home and place a marker by the tree
- 4. Think about ways you might get to know your special tree and care for it.
