

MATERIALS:

Different coloured tissue paper

Glass


Electric candle

Glue

Scissors



- Cut tissue paper into different shapes and sizes
- 2. Put glue on the area of the glass that you are working on
- 3. Randomly place the paper on the glue
- 4. Repeat steps 2 & 3 until the outside of the glass is covered in tissue paper
- 5. Turn on the electric candle and place it inside the glass
- 6. Sit back and look at what you have made!




