This is one of the most well-known bible verses and I was wondering



just how enormous God's love for us is and as that's the case how would we measure it. We live in a time when people like to measure everything – so how could we do this?

When I open a packet mix cake to bake a cake, I have to add certain ingredients to it, such as oil. The instructions tell me how much I need, so that's how much I put into the mix. Psalm 23:1-5 includes 'The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want...my cup overflows.' So I guess if the cup overflows with God's love, I suppose we couldn't use a measuring cup to measure it.

If I was to ask a builder to build me a tree house in the backyard I would have to give them the measurement for how high off the ground it had to be, so they would know how many steps I would need to get up into the tree house. So this time I would need to supply a tape measure, is this how I could measure God's love? Psalm 108:4 tells us that God's love is higher than the heavens. If that's the case then I don't think we can use a tape measure, because there isn't one that long in all the world!

So perhaps I could measure time. Everyone is so busy and having enough time to do what's important. I wonder if I could use a clock to measure how much time it takes before I stop being interested in reading about Jesus, doing Pebble puzzles, colouring in pictures about the story or listening to the songs today in Pebbles. I wonder if I could use a clock to measure how long God's love will last. Psalm 103:17 reminds me that God's love lasts forever and it doesn't run out. That is so fantastic, I suppose it's no use trying to measure God's love through a clock.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish, but have eternal life." So, just how can we measure a love like that? The truth is, we can't. Even better still, we don't need to, but we do need to experience it.

The prayer for you today is this, that you understand how wide, how long how high, and how deep God's love really is. May you experience God's love to the fullest measure.

Dear God, thank you for your love which so big that you gave your one and only Son so that we could have eternal life. In Jesus' name, amen.




