


ST NINIAN'S UNITING CHURCH FEBRUARY 9th 2025

'JESUS IS CALLING' BASED ON LUKE 5:1-11

Today's story is about going fishing. Last year when I went on holidays, we stayed with our family in the coastal town called Foster. We had a lovely time. Our youngest child brought his boat with him so he could take his children out fishing and put some crab



pots in the water. They had a lovely time, but for me the thing is while I enjoy the peace and quiet fishing needs for the fish not to be scared, I don't like to actually catch a fish. Mainly because I don't like to put a worm on the hook, and I don't like to harm the fish when it bites on the worm on the hook. Some people like the experience of fishing whether they catch anything or not. But that's not for me.

On our holiday Hayden and his children would get up early to go fishing and I noticed that it wouldn't be too long before the children got a bit bored with it and would go off and do something else. Hayden, on the other hand, stayed there for ages and came back empty handed and the crab pots were also empty. No fish, no crabs!

This story reminds of the time when some fishermen also went out in a boat to fish and caught nothing – that is until Jesus came along.

One day Jesus was standing by the sea of Galilee. A large crowd of people started to gather around him. He saw some fishermen nearby who were cleaning and mending their nets, so he climbed into one of their boats. He asked one of the men whose name was Peter, to put the boat out a little way from the shore. Jesus took a seat in the boat and began to teach the people.

When he had finished teaching, Jesus said to Peter, "Put the boat further out into the deep water and let your nets down to catch some fish." Peter said, "We've been fishing all night and haven't caught a thing, but if you say so, we will let down the nets one more time." An amazing thing happened! When they pulled the nets up, there were so many fish the nets began to break. As they pulled the fish into the boat, the boat began to sink, the number of fish they caught were so heavy. When Peter and his friends saw this, they we surprised and joyful even if they were a little frightened.
