

MARY GIVES JESUS AN EXPENSIVE GIFT

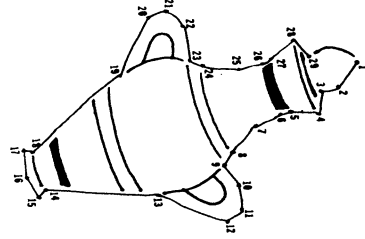

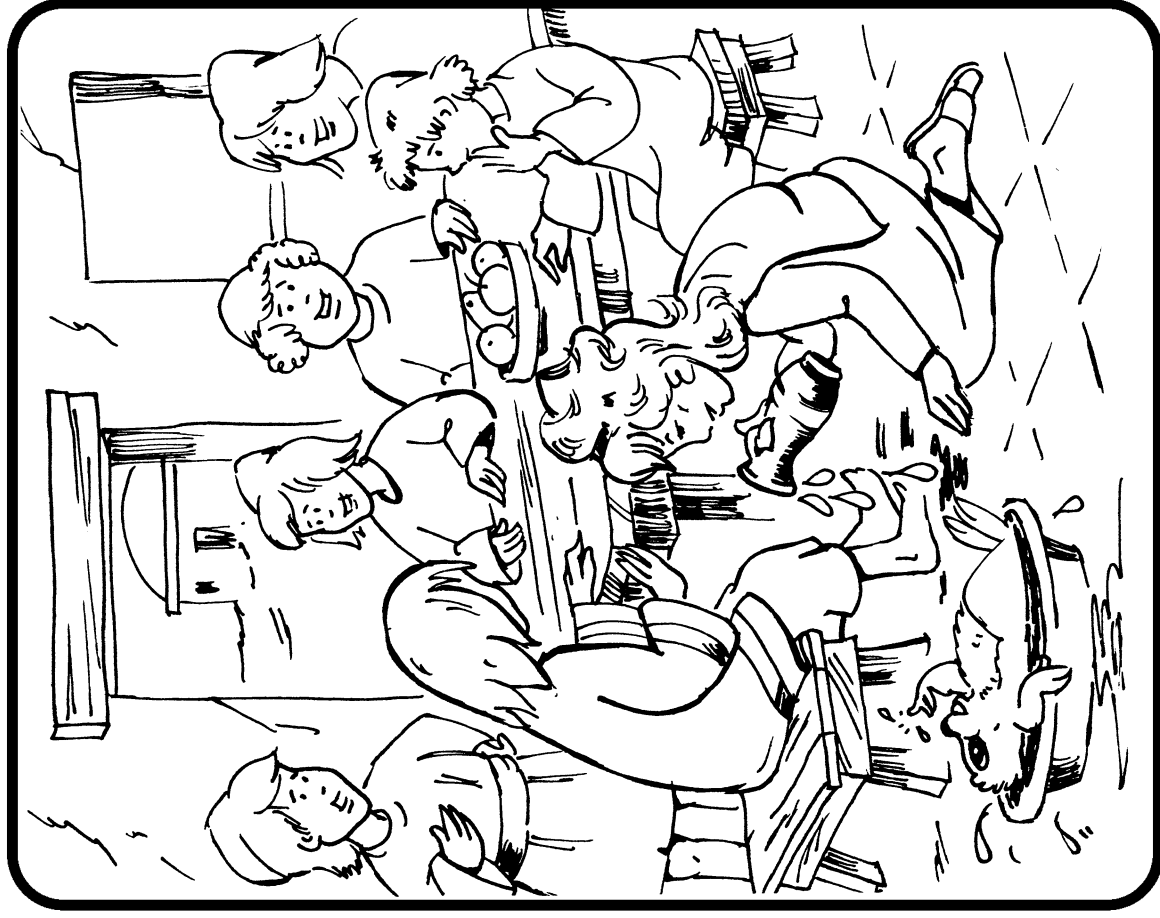

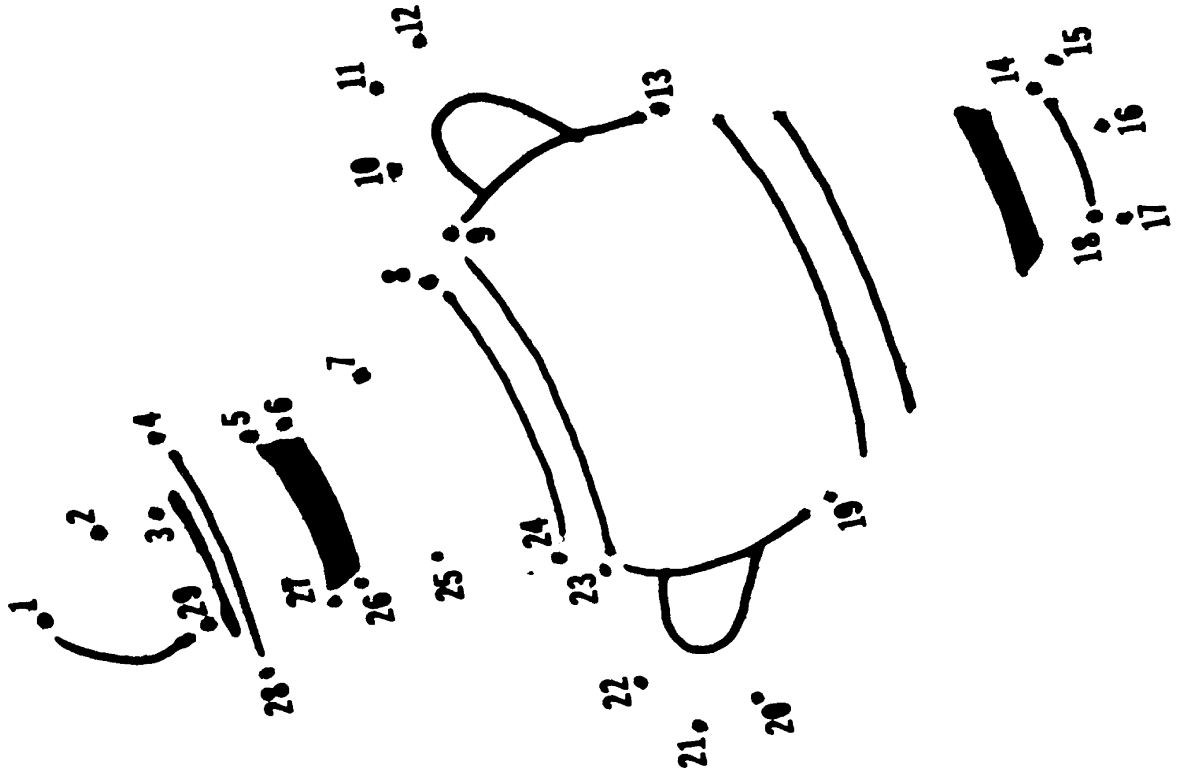
