A story based on Acts 1:1-11

One of greatest things about going to something like the night markets even though it can be very cold, is the huge smile on the faces of the children who have a balloon. Many parents tie them to the pram or their child's wrist so that they don't go 'up, up and away!' If they want to take them home, then they have to hold on to them. Another reason to have a balloon is when your mum is having a baby, and you want to let your friends know if it's going to be boy or a girl is to have a coloured balloon. When you have a balloon for this reason you don't tie them to anything, you just let them go 'up, up and away!' The smiles on this occasion are also big and it's fun to watch the balloon float very high up into sky until it disappears.

In our bible story for today from Acts, we learn that when Jesus was ready to go back to heaven, He took his disciples aside to make sure that they understood everything that had happened to Him. Jesus explained why it was important for Him to be crucified and to be raised from the dead to fulfill what the bible had said about Him. He also told them that he was going to return to His Father in heaven (God) and that the Holy Spirit would come to be with them.

At first, the disciples were sad that Jesus would be leaving them, but then the Bible tells us that Jesus opened their minds so they would understand. Jesus couldn't stay with them, His friends couldn't tie Jesus up either. Then, an amazing thing happened. Luke, a friend of Jesus tells us in Acts, that Jesus lifted his hands and blessed His disciples. While He was blessing them, He lifted up and was taken up into heaven 'up, up and away!' just like the balloons went up into the sky.



They stayed continually in the temple (church) singing and praising God.
